Summary Annual Report Intermountain Ironworkers' Tax Deferral Plan

This is a summary of the annual report of the Intermountain Ironworkers' Tax Deferral Plan, Employer Identification Number: 62-1473489, for the period January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. The annual report has been filed with the Internal Revenue Service, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided from a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$8,091,514. These expenses included \$518,494 in administrative operating expenses and \$7,573,020 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 4977 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the year.

The value of the plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan was \$65,744,078 as of December 31, 2015 compared to \$67,036,874 as of January 1, 2015. During the plan year the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$1,292,796. The Plan had a total income of \$6,798,718 including \$6,913,107 in employer contributions, \$0.00 in rollovers, \$347,106 in losses from investments, and \$232,717 in other income.
